The Great 50 Days of Easter

Understanding something of the Jewish background of our Christian tradition helps us to deepen both our knowledge and our experience of our own tradition. Easter's close association with Passover connects the remembrance of the Hebrew people's liberation from slavery in Egypt to another liberation from death to life in the Resurrection.

There is a similar linkage between the time of the Passover and the time of Pentecost, what we call the "Great 50 Days" of Easter. In the Jewish tradition, Pentecost is known as *Shavuot*, the Feast of Weeks. Originally an agricultural feast, it came to be associated with the giving of the Law to the Jewish People by Moses at Sinai in the Wilderness. The 50 days between Passover and *Shavuot* was a time of great anticipation where day to day, week to week the people would "count the Omer" until the day the law was delivered.

Pentecost, in Christian tradition, represents another kind of gift, not of the Law but of the Spirit, the promised gift of the risen Christ. The "Great 50 Days" is, therefore, not only a time of anticipation of the Spirit, but also a time to reflect more deeply on the meaning of the Resurrection and our own rebirth as disciples of Jesus Christ. Baptism is, therefore, appropriate during this time, which is considered a single, extended Sunday of *alleluias*.

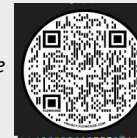
